

# 2018 MAJOR – Spanish and Latin American Studies

(Qualifying Major for Bachelor of Arts with the degree of Bachelor of Education (Primary))

Students completing a major in Spanish and Latin American Studies develop proficiency in Spanish across a range of modes of communication. They gain an understanding of the society and culture of the countries where Spanish is spoken. Students learn about cultural differences, analyse the relationship between language and culture, and apply skills in cross-cultural communication. The Spanish and Latin American Studies major has a distinctive cross-cultural approach and includes opportunities for innovative modes of learning including online delivery, in-country studies and internships.
