

# 2019 MAJOR – French and Francophone Studies

(Qualifying Major for Bachelor of Arts with the degree of Bachelor of Laws)

Students completing a major in French and Francophone Studies develop proficiency in French across a range of modes of communication. They gain an understanding of the society and culture of the countries where French is spoken. Students learn about cultural differences, analyse the relationship between language and culture, and apply skills in cross-cultural communication. The French and Francophone Studies major has a distinctive cross-cultural approach and includes opportunities for innovative modes of learning including online delivery, in-country studies and internships.

- To progress to Intermediate French from Introductory French you must complete FRN125 or FRN131 in Session 3.
- \* *Only students with previous knowledge of the language will be able to commence their language major in Session 2 and must seek advice from their academic advisor prior to enrolment, except students who have completed HSC Beginners Band 4-6, who should enrol directly into FRN123. All other students should commence their language units in Session 1, 2020.*
- Please note that you should enrol in LAW109, LAWS104 and LAWS108 in 2020.
- Consider what units you will want to study in second and third year. Prerequisite requirements for those units must be completed prior to enrolment in the higher-level unit.
- You must complete a Professional and Community Engagement (PACE) unit with a LAWS prefix as part of your
