

2019 MAJOR – Chinese Studies

(Qualifying Major for Bachelor of Business Administration with the degree of Bachelor of Arts)

Students completing a major in Chinese Studies develop proficiency in Chinese across a range of modes of communication. They gain an understanding of the society and culture of the countries where Chinese is spoken. Students learn about cultural differences, analyse the relationship between language and culture, and apply skills in cross-cultural communication. The Chinese Studies major has a distinctive cross-cultural approach and includes opportunities for innovative modes of learning including online delivery, in-country studies and internships.

- It may be possible to satisfy the requirements of your degree by taking a different selection of units in your first session from those suggested above.
- ** All students selecting Chinese Studies must submit a language biography with a pre-requisite waiver request on ask.mq.edu.au so that staff can determine at which level, and in which units, you may begin your studies.*
- Only students with previous knowledge of the language will be able to commence their language major in Session 2 and may be able to begin this language at Intermediate level and must seek advice from their academic advisor prior to enrolment. All other students should commence their language units in Session 1, 2020.
- Consider what units you will want to study in second and third year. Prerequisite requirements for those units must be completed prior to enrolment in the higher-level unit.
