

2019 MAJOR – English as a Foreign Language

(Qualifying Major for Bachelor of Business Administration with the degree of Bachelor of Arts)

The English as a Foreign Language (EFL) major is designed for students from a non-English speaking background. The major consists of English language studies together with a range of units on culture and communication. Commencing students can complete a full major within a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Global Business. As a second major, minor or elective, EFL suits students in various degrees who need development of high level English for their careers, including students for whom excellent English is an educational or professional requirement. EFL equips students with the knowledge and skills of cross-cultural communication, exploration of differences in the English-speaking world, structural properties of English, and understanding the language in professional, academic and social situations.
