Students completing a major in Russian Studies develop proficiency in Russian across a range of modes of communication. They gain an understanding of the society and culture of the countries where Russian is spoken. Students learn about cultural differences, analyse the relationship between language and culture, and apply skills in cross-cultural communication. The Russian Studies major has a distinctive cross-cultural approach and includes opportunities for innovative modes of learning including online delivery, in-country studies and internships.
