

# 2019 MAJOR – Entrepreneurship

(Qualifying Major for Bachelor of Commerce with the degree of Bachelor of Arts - Psychology)

This four-year program provides a joint qualification in commerce and psychology. The program lets you gain a comprehensive understanding of business functions, strategy and skills whilst equipping you with knowledge of a wide range of fundamental psychological concepts which will help you understand how people think, act and feel, and be able to apply these concepts across a range of business areas.

Entrepreneurship involves a wide scope of activities such as evaluating ideas, sourcing and organising resources, and weighing the risks and rewards associated with the new ventures. This major will help you to learn the skills of identifying and developing opportunities.

Students wishing to progress with psychology training can transfer from this degree to the Bachelor of Commerce with the degree of Bachelor of Psychology (Honours) upon meeting entry requirements.
