Study professional accounting with law and better understand the role of commercial and corporate law while preparing to practice as a qualified accountant. Accounting is the collection, measurement and communication of economic information which is used for planning, reporting and decision making. This combined degree includes the study of techniques and elements of finance, management, microeconomics, marketing, auditing and statistics. Macquarie Law will give you knowledge of legal principles and the critical and analytic skills to really understand them. You'll study established areas such as constitutional law, international law, contract law and family law. You'll also look at areas of contemporary concern such as consumer law, environmental law, health law and information technology law.
