(Qualifying Major for Bachelor of Human Sciences)

This major is designed for students who wish to gain a wide range of theoretical knowledge and practical skills in movement science. It includes studies in human anatomy, human physiology, psychology, research methods and human movement.

To make the most out of the Bachelor of Human Science it is strongly recommended that students undertake a second major along with the Human Movement Major.

- For a double major complete required units for both majors where possible in the first year. Consult the criteria found at www.handbook.mq.edu.au/2019/Majors. Suggested second majors include;

 - Communication Disorders
 - Community Services
 - Counselling Theory and Principles
 - Language and Professional Communication
 - Public Health: Policy and Promotion
- Consider what units you will want to study in second and third year. Prerequisite requirements for those units must be completed prior to enrolment in the higher-level unit.
- You must select a Professional and Community Engagement (PACE) unit as part of the elective component of your degree. It is important to plan ahead for this requirement and allocate elective space for your chosen PACE unit. A list of eligible units is available at www.handbook.mq.edu.au/2019/Units/PACE.
- It may be possible to satisfy the requirements of your degree by taking a different selection of units in your first session from those suggested above.
